Ewethful Fiber Farm & Mill is a mini-fiber mill and retail shop in Halsey, Oregon. Owned by Kim Biegler, the Ewethful Fiber Farm & Mill produces and processes various animal fibers as well as creating yarn. Ewethful Fiber Farm & Mill's retail shop is housed in a refurbished, historic building. The shop sells fiber products, handmade goods and local antiques. Ewethful Fiber Farm & Mill also offers classes in the fiber arts.

Project Description

Kim approached A.wordsmith for support publicizing Ewethful Fiber Farm & Mill's grand opening. Kim and Ewethful Fiber Farm & Mill faced a challenge in their location. Though only a short drive off I-5, Halsey was not a natural destination or rest stop. Key Results
